

MISSION OVERVIEW

JTF GTMO conducts safe, humane, legal and transparent care and custody of detainees, including those convicted by military commission.

We conduct intelligence collection, analysis and dissemination for the safety and security of detainees and JTF Guantanamo personnel working in facilities as well as in support of ongoing overseas contingency operations. We also provide support to law enforcement, investigations and the Office of Military Commissions.

In the spirit of transparency, more than 3,400 news media representatives have been here since January 2002.
