JTF GTMO conducts operations to collect, analyze, and disseminate intelligence in support of local force protection and ongoing overseas contingency operations.

Interrogations are conducted in strict compliance with Army Field Manual 2-22.3:

- All interrogations are voluntary
- A portion of all interrogations are requested by the detainee

Interrogations for the majority of detainees are limited to:

- Safety of camp personnel and detainees
- Specific source-directed requirements from Combatant Commanders
- Support to organizations such as the Criminal Investigation Task Force (CITF) and Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI)

Intelligence support to legal proceedings:

Intelligence analysts provide support to Military Commissions and Habeas Corpus proceedings in U.S. Federal Court.
